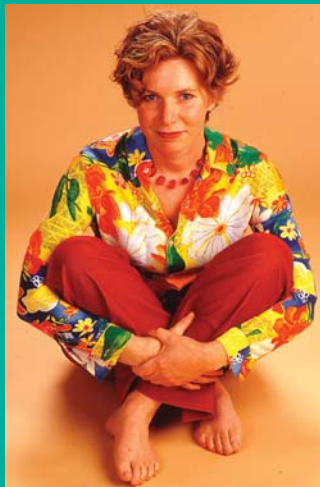


Singing in Paradise
